











Annotation: Even though the importance of good leadership skills in entrepreneurship is widely acknowledged, it is not always clear which qualities are necessary to be a good leader. In this lesson the learners will learn and reflect on qualities that define good leadership, e.g. enthusiasm, integrity, loyalty etc. The material is based on a Forbes article '8 Essential Qualities That Define Great Leadership'.

Marginal Key Competence:

Ability to recognize and develop leadership skills

Expected Output:

Students know what qualities and skills make a good leader.

Keywords: leadership, coaching, team management, personal skills development

Objectives of the course:

- -To learn about qualities and skills that are necessary to become a good leader.
- -To reflect on these qualities and skills and come up with ideas on how they could be developed in the current environment.
- Ouration: 40 m worksheet "Leadership"
- Theoretical part explanation of the content:

- 1. Draw a mind map. Wirte on a flipchart or a whiteboard words 'good leader'. Ask learners to say things that pop up in their minds that are connected to the notion of a 'good leader'. Create a mind map by writing down their ideas.
- 2. Work with handouts "Leadership". Students in pairs or groups of 3 people work on the handout. They follow the instructions provided on the handout.
- 3. Class discussion. Each pair/group presents the main idea of one of the paragraphs. Further the teacher can show the class the whole article and ask to what points they agree or disagree.
- 4. Reflection. Learners reflect on how they could strengthen their own leadership skills.
