Entrepreneurship education is declared by the European Commission as a key factor for competitiveness in a globalised economy and is set out in the "Europe 2020" strategy in an action to promote entrepreneurship in order to help entrepreneurs to implement their intensions.

By developing innovative approaches, modern tools and techniques for teachers, professors and trainers, the *ENTER* project partners support achieving this aim. For further information, please take a look at the *ENTER* website, which is available on enter-info.eu/.

The materials, developed within the *ENTER* project, focus on "Innovation", "Teamwork & Communication", "Decision Making" and "Project Management". Further, there is an "Assessment" section, which is – along with the aforementioned modules – also available on the *ENTER OER platform* (https://moodle.isq.pt/course/view.php?id=43). Presenting the platform and the contents on there, was one of the main topics of the round table that was conducted in Vienna on 25 July 2018. In total, 16 participants participated; many of them were (self-)employed and came from different working sectors, like gastronomy and tourism.

The developed materials have already been tested, along with the *ENTER OER* platform (Open Educational Resources), by ten experienced educators from Austria between the End of March and May 2018. The evaluation of their numerious feedback, qualitative as well as quantitative, was also a topic on the agenda of this multiplier event.

Moreover, the round-table participants were invited to give further feedback and recommendations for the training course, see methods/ approaches on how to improve the integration of entrepreneurship education at schools. They highlighted the innovative methods and relevance of the material.




About the satisfaction regarding the venue and the quality of seeing and hearing of the presentations, where respondents could choose between "yes" and "no", all participants answered with "yes".

More than two third of the respondents (69%) said that they were very well informed about the objective of the event. The remaining 31% agreed that they were well informed.






The event lived up to my expectations.

Regarding how the event met the expectations, 69% rated with highest score and 31% with good score.




11 respondents, which is 69% rated the job relevancy with the highest score. 31% agreed that the content is relevant to their jobs.





Evaluation of the Multiplier Event Design


The event objectives were clear to me.




Three quarter of the participants were strongly agree with the statement that the activities gave them sufficient practice and feedback. One quarter agreed on the same.



The intellectual output objectives were clear to me.



The activities in this event gave me sufficient practice and feedback to intellectual output.







69% of all participants strongly agree that they will be able to use the learned topics in the practice, still the remaining 31% agree to that.






The multiplier event / intellectual output was a good way for me to learn this content.
